Tommy is not with us anymore and left our club on a free transfer. The good work that he did still needs to be done so please give some thought to how you might be able to help. Planting and weeding etc. is necessary. The club was always awash with colour, and it would be nice to make that happen again. More details on the plans will be given later.



Social Activities

Although we are a bowling club, we still want to give members the opportunity to have other activities. Thursday afternoon Friendlies with other clubs is semi competitive bowling without the pressure of being in a league team. So are the internal club competitions. The Social Group will manage these but also investigates other club

member get-togethers that doesn't involve bowling at all. However, as the weather begins to improve and the dark and wet winter is behind us, we know that bowling will, understandably, take priority and therefore club outings will be kept to a minimum or held in the closed season. Currently we have only one lunch per year and that is at Christmas. If you would like more, we are considering another one at a suitable time but we hope to add in a quiz and a game of bingo to liven up the afternoon. If you're interested let us know and we will make it happen.

The **Darts and Domino** sessions each Tuesday at 2pm have been great so thanks to everyone who came along. Really enjoyable and raised good money for the club. We'll be sorry to see this finish until next year.

After the opening of the club the first competition, set for **Sunday, 29th March**, will be the '**Opening Fours**'. This is the annual doubles game, and the entry form and notice will be on the noticeboard on the opening day. The difference this year is you **must** have your name on the form before the closing date on the form or you will not be able to play. This is so the draw can be done in advance to speed up the process. We will also ensure that the competition will hopefully finish on the same day. If, because of a high number of applicants, it cannot be, the following Thursday will be reserved for the final. This format will apply to all other one-off club competitions but not the Alpha Trophy or Hornby Cup as they take place throughout the season.

Once again, we will be holding our annual '**Charity Day**' it will be held, as usual, in the clubhouse and will take place on **Sunday 5th July**.
